## **Notes from the President:**

The December club meeting will be held at the King George County School Board Office at 9100 St Anthony's Rd. This is the old King George Elementary School. Coming East on Rt. 3 from Fredericksburg into King George, pass the traffic light at Rt. 206 & Rt. 3. You will see the Valero convenience store on the left. Go approx. ½ mile and then turn right onto St. Anthony's Rd. The school will be on your right from this direction. (If you continued on route 3 until it narrowed down to a single lane, you went too far! Turn around and turn left at St. Anthony's Catholic Church. The school is just behind St. Anthony's.) There will be no work party this month.

This month's meeting is the NVGC Annual meeting. It is the time when we elect new officers for the upcoming year. Please make sure you return your proxy ballot (included in this newsletter) to John LoBuglio prior to that date or show up in person to vote. The ballot should be postmarked by December 13 to get in on time. Please make sure to include your printed name, signature and date your ballot. Please remember our rules specify that associate members can only hunt in the presence of the dues-paying member. They are not allowed to walk around and hunt by themselves. If you bring an associate member with you to hunt, they must remain with you under your direct supervision.

During Deer General Firearms season, our ranges are closed on Mondays, Tuesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays. It was reported that some members were seen at the rifle/pistol range on one of these days. Hunters could be in the impact area and you could put one of them in danger. Please commit to memory the days that the ranges are open (Sundays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays) and do not use the ranges on any other day until Hunting Season is over. Our normal schedule will resume on Sunday, January 3, 2005. If you qualify for a NVGC Hunting Permit and need one, please see Joe Graninger, our Membership Secretary.
