Work projects for August:

Using the DR along the road to push back the saplings, along the archery main trail and station lanes and the areas in front of the skeet and trap houses where the tractor can not mow.

Trimming the trees along the road and by the picnic roof, rifle cover and pistol cover.

I bought some RoundUP for us and will bring my sprayer to kill the grass growing in the parking lot.

Fix the door on the skinning shed.

Clean out drainage ditch next to picnic shelter. Smooth dirt around picnic shelter where Gene excavated it with backhoe and sweep picnic shelter.

Cut down marked trees around picnic area and old tractor shed.

Lay final row of block for new garage. Back fill around garage foundation and plant grass seed.

Trim in front of the 3 signs on Rte 218 with weedwhackers.

Paint "Stay Dry" cement based paint on inside of trap house, Fix lock on No. 3 High house, and do PM on the trap and skeet machines.

Shotgun News:

We are in the meat of the shotgun competition season. Our shooters are posting some great scores at big shoots around the country. Jeff Jones broke a 96 to win the 24-25 group and lots of money in the Federal Handicap trap match at the Virginia state championships in Winchester. Jon Yagla had a 195 in the 16 yard singles championship, but lost a shootoff to Art Boddel. Yagla backed it up with a 97 in handicap at Winchester in the August shoot, moving him back to 24.5 yards. Frank Baker, one of our scattergunners from across the river, stormed through the Maryland state shoot. After struggling for two seasons at handicap, came out with his hair on fire to post a 98 to tie for first place in the Clint Clayton Handicap. He followed with a 197 in the Maryland singles championship. The shoot off with one Maryland's leading shooters went two boxes of shells, with Frank having to settle for runner up. Frank won High All Around in B, taking three big trophies altogether.

Our July monthly club match drew in a dozen competitors. The temperatures and the scores were about the same. Highlights: Mike Thompson and Yagla finished singles one target behind Robert Hayden from Tappahannock (98). JD Stamper from Tappahannock won the handicap with 91. The scores went back up for doubles, with Yagla, 97, over Robert Hayden, 96. Ernie Jones had a fine 95 in C, over Chip King, 94.

Preference for relays 1 - 5 will be honored with pre registration and payment of entry fees until 30 minutes prior to stage 1.

Rules: In accordance with the current Civilian Marksmanship

Program (CMP) rules, 9th edition:

John Garand Match:

As issued M-1 Garand, M1941 Johnson Rifle, M-1 Carbine; Springfield/Vintage Rifle Match:
As issued 1903 Springfield Series, Model 1917, U. S. Krag. Foreign Military Rifle:

As issued by the Armed forces of a country other than the U. S. Semi-automatic or automatic rifles are not permitted.

AWARDS: Each participant will qualify to purchase an M1 Garand from the CMP. Application packets for the purchase of a standard M1 Garand will be available at the match. Medals for aggregate scores will be awarded in each category for 1st (6 entries), 2nd (12 entries), and 3rd (18 entries) places.

COURSE OF FIRE: Entry fee includes 30-06 M2 Ball ammunition or 30 Caliber M-1 Carbine ammunition.

Stage 1: 20 shots, prone, 20 minutes

Stage 2: 10 shots, standing to prone, 70 seconds;

Stage 3: 10 shots, standing to sitting or kneeling, 60 seconds

Stage 4: 10 shots, standing, 10 minutes;

FIVE SIGHTERS WILL ALLOWED BEFORE STAGE 1.

Three minutes prep time will be provided for each stage. Fifteen minutes between stages 2 and 3 are required for scoring and target change.

SCORING: All scoring will be by the competitors.
