Shotgun Competition Highlights:

Frank Baker broke a 99 at 16 yards to win class A in a preliminary 16 yard match at the Maryland State Shoot. He backed it up with a 94 to win the 22-24 yardage group the same afternoon. Phil Bushong broke a 99 in ATA competition at Dunnbrook. Rick Demerle hauled three fine trophies out of Winchester after the Virginia State Shoot. He broke 97 handicap targets to win the preliminary event, followed with a 91 in doubles to win a class trophy, and then won a Virginia Singles Championship match class trophy with a 99. He also made it to the Old Dominion shoot off with a 196. Jon Yagla was there too, winning the Virginia State Class A doubles championship with a 96, after a shoot off where he dominated the field. Yagla was also presented a trophy for placing 6th on the Virginia State Trapshooting Team.

Skeet shooters have been equally productive. Mike Thompson ran 100 straight 12 ga. targets at the Battlefield Open in Fredericksburg. He had to take them to a shoot off, where he ran another 102 targets to win the championship. Kevin Montrief turned in a personal best in 12 gauge with a blistering 98, and followed it up with another personal best 98 in 20 gauge. Chip King was atop of the 12 gauge D Class with a personnel best 92, and then went on to best all comers in the five way shoot off to take the class honors. Bob King broke 99 for a ticket to five man shoot off in B, where he bested the lot. We welcome Bob to class A.

Attention hunters:

I intend to distribute hunting permits after the August 19 work party. Hunting permits will also be available after the September 16 work party and at the gun club open house. Please plan to come to the club on one of those dates to receive your permit, and be sure that you have the required four (4) work party credits. Thank you, and good hunting.
