Keep an extra eye out for any activity in impact areas of all the ranges. Also note that it has been announced on the trail website that a hunt club has been authorized to use vehicles along the RROW from Rte 609 to the shooting facility property in-order to access adjacent leased property during the hunting season. Please report any activity noticed on the RROW, adjacent to facility property, to Jerry Gibson, the president of the Shooting Facility.

Please be conscientious not to leave the lock opened to the combination number after opening to prevent non members from learning the access combination. The EC requests all members who observe any trespassers and unauthorized vehicles on facility property to report it to the SF Board. Also, if any destruction of property, the breaking of club rules that cause unsafe conditions, or any dangerous situations and hazards on the range, to report the incident(s) to a club officer as soon as possible. Include a brief description of those individuals with their vehicle and tag numbers and the date and time of the infraction. Also, be conscientious and help keep the facility litter free. Pick up any trash and garbage to take out with you.

As always, I would like to stress the importance of safety by all members and their families and guests while on the facility property. *Merry Christmas, Happy Holidays and New Year to all during this holiday season!*
