Shotgun Range News:

We caught the weather right for two very nice shotgun matches this fall. We had a 300 target ATA Trap match followed the next weekend by a four-gun 400 target NSSA Skeet match. Robert Hayden from Tappahannock topped Mike Thompson, 27 and 26 yards respectively, for Trap HOA. It was pretty windy, but Frank Baker and Jon Yagla with 94s went to a shootoff round in the 16 yard match, where Yagla prevailed with a straight run of the extra targets. Hayden won the doubles match with an 89.

In the NSSA skeet match the locals got stomped by Robert Williams of Bowling Green, who just got back from winning the Ducks Unlimited Trophy and NRA Trophy at the World Skeet Shoot in San Antonio. He posted 99,98,97,97 in the four guns, respectively. Yagla hung in there a while with him, with a 98 in the 12 gauge, but fell farther and farther back, finishing with a 379 for second place. We welcome veteran NSSA shooters Travis Vindich and Tom Blair, who just joined our club.

Frank Manuel has groomed the lawns and they look really nice for the winter. Dennis McCauley touched up the grass seeding bare spots, applied additional fertilizer, and aerated the ground. My 90 year old mother saw the range for the first time and said, Wow! That looks great! Now I see why you go over there all the time! The new garage looks great, too. Any visitor will get a great first impression.

The new targets stand out against the gray, barren trees and are quite easy to break. phil Bushong posted another 50 straight skeet score and Bob King broke a 75 and backed it up with 25 more the next day for his first 100. Congratulations to both of these dedicated shooters. The evening Annies draw a few more shooters each time. It must be the good food and slow targets.
