Notes from the President:

There is much maintenance work to be done on the ranges and facility, so I encourage all members to come out for the workparties and participate, as they are able, in these efforts.

It is each and every member's responsibility to ensure safety in the proper handling of firearms and care of the property. In the February newsletter, we published an article by Gene Hodgson outlining a number of problems occurring on the ranges. There seems to be a small number of irresponsible folks that are trashing and destroying the ranges and causing dangerous situations with the debris left on the range. It is every member's responsibility to take care of the club and facility property and ensure safety at all times. The EC requests all members who observe any destruction of property, the breaking of club rules that cause unsafe conditions and hazards, to report the incident to a club officer as soon as possible. Include a brief description of those individuals with their vehicle and tag numbers and the date and time of the infraction. The EC is also interested in the observation of unsafe firearms handling incidents and a reminder to all that Class III firearms are not allowed for use on the facility ranges and property. Every member needs to take pride in the care of the property and ensure for the safety and wellbeing of all.

A reminder to all first year members: In addition to the financial obligations, each new member is required to contribute a minimum of four (4) workdays during their first year. Failure to complete the required workdays within the first year of membership could result in not being tendered membership renewal. Anyone having problems attending regularly scheduled workparties are encouraged to contact the XO. He is the activities director who will assign special projects to enable members to accomplish their work credits.

The EC is currently looking for a volunteer to coordinate and begin to make arrangements for next year's annual club dinner. Please contact an EC member if you are interested.

As always, I would like to stress the importance of safety by all members and their families and guests while on the facility property.
