## **Shotgun Corner:**

Our trap shooters have turned in some pretty good performances at Dunbrooke and Winchester. Chip King shot a really fine 97 in Handicap match at the VTA "Hall of Fame" and earned a yard. Jon Yagla posted a 99 in the singles event. Our informal club matches have been well attended: to win the little 50 on Fridays you will need a 49, 46, 48 in singles, handicap, and doubles, respectively. Visitors to the Memorial Day 50-50 skeet and trap match saw some good shooting, where Jason Falbe ran a nice straight, but couldn't win it all against Jon Yagla's 96. We are working with two fine junior shooters: Kyle Bone (VA) and John Martin (MD). They qualified in competition for slots at the 4H Shooting Sports National Shotgun Championships in June in South Dakota. They have been regulars at the practices and did very well in the 50-50. Martin won the Jim Bumbry "Bumbry's Boy" memorial skeet trophy in a very close match with Kyle Bone. Kyle stumbled a little getting started, lost the trap, and then won the skeet segment. These evenly matched competitors are great shooters and great sports, and will serve Virginia and Maryland well in South Dakota.

I understand there are a group of pistol shooters that meet on Tuesdays at 3:00, Benchrest shoots the fourth Saturday of every month and Cowboy Action the forth Sunday, times are at the end of the newsletter.
